^{*}The final confirmed data is not expected to be released by the DfE until February 2026. As such, this data reflects prior releases alongside successful re-marks that we have had confirmed. This data will be updated here, as appropriate, once the data is released.

Notes:

All GCSE subjects are graded 1 to 9 with a 4 equivalent to a C and designated as a Standard Pass. A grade 5 is equivalent to the top part of a C grade or the lower end of a B grade and is designated as a Strong Pass.

The EBacc – this measure recognises students who achieve at least a pass in all of English, Maths, Science, a Language, History or Geography

A8 score – the point score achieved by students on average across their best 8 subjects. This is calculated by adding up the points for their best 6 subjects plus English and Maths whose scores are double-weighted.
